0 Preliminary Remarks

Subject to current developments, the DLRG Cup 2023 will be able to be held without restrictions due to Corona requirements. However, all participants are still encouraged to observe the usual and known hygienic measures. Should one or more participants of a team show symptoms of illness before or during their arrival, we ask the team to refrain from travelling and (further) participation in the interest of all athletes. The organizer expressly reserves the right to remove individual athletes or teams from the competition in case of suspicion of a possible infection and to isolate them from the rest of the field.

In addition, the organizer reserves the right to make short-term changes to this announcement if it is necessary, due to legal requirements or other requirements. These do not give reason to an extraordinary right of withdrawal or the refund of entry fees and participation fees.

However, the NEM obligation does not apply to any necessary designation of substitute athletes.

The organizer also reserves the right to cancel the DLRG Cup at short notice due to corona conditions with reimbursement of the entry and participation fees. There is no claim compensation on the part of the organizer, e.g., for cancellation costs for booked accommodations.

1 Competition

1.1 Competition /Time Schedule

Disciplines at DLRG Cup will be held in heats, semi-finals (same for female and male) depending on number of participants.

The organizer reserves the right to change location and time of the event at short notice for a special reason. He assumes no liability for costs incurred for clubs, if they enter contractual obligations with third parties, e.g., for accommodation services.

1.2 Age Groups

Classification will be conducted in the open class.

1.3 Events

1.3.1 Single Events

Each competitor takes part with his registered disciplines in the "Three Individual events" classification. Maximum number of starts in single events per competitor is four; the three best results will be counted.

- Surf Race
- Board Race
- Surf Ski Race
- Oceanwoman/Oceanman (Final as eliminator-race)
- Beach Flags
- Beach Sprint

possible replacement discipline in case of unsuitable weather conditions

- Beach run 1 or 2 km

1.3.2 Team Events

Each team is allowed to compete in only one relay per team and discipline (female and male) and one mixed team (two female and two male / Ocean Lifesaver Relay).

- Board-Rescue
- Rescue Tube Rescue
- Oceanwoman-/Oceanman Relay
- Beach Sprint Relay
- Ocean Lifesaver Relay

possible replacement discipline in case of unsuitable weather conditions

- 3x1km Beach Run Relay

1.4 Eligibility/Start Conditions

Eligible are

- a) Club teams of the DLRG
- b) Club teams of full members of the International Life Saving Federation

These teams have to consist of minimum one (1) and maximum twelve (12) competitors belonging to the age group born 2007 and older. Maximum six of these competitors have to be female or male participants. For each club only one team can be registered.

All athletes under the age of 18 must additionally complete and sign the appendix for the participation of underage athletes in order to be granted a starting authorization.

For Interclub participants according to b) the conditions of participation formulated in the English call for applications apply.

1.5 Classification

Pointscore occurs to ILS Rulebook (1.6.) and "Merkblatt Sport-05-23" (Attachement 3)

1.5.1 Classification of Disciplines

At the DLRG Cup the first three places in the following categories will be honoured:

- a) Single events f/m
- b) Relays f/m

1.5.2 DLRG Cup Overall

After finishing all disciplines, the first three places in the following categories will be honoured:

c) Classification of "three single events" f/m.

For each competitor (f/m) the results of his/her best three single events will be counted

d) Team Classification

For each team the four competitors (f/m) with the best number of points in the "three single events" and the points of all female and male relays including mixed Ocean Relay will be counted.

1.5.3 Publication of Results

The results will be published on the DLRG homepage and at https://dlrg.rescuesoft.info

Certificates are only issued if requested by Email to cup@dsg.dlrg.de

1.5.4 Award Ceremony

All Award Ceremonies, described in 1.5.1, take place during the competition directly on the beach. They will be announced about 15 minutes in advance and will also be held if the winner is absent. The DLRG Cup Overall scoring (1.5.2) and the classification of the "three single events" are carried out during the closing ceremony.

1.6 Competition Rulebook

All competitions at DLRG Cup are carried out according to the International Rulebook of ILS International Life Saving Federation in the currently valid version:

During the event the manager and the judge may decide about changes concerning the carrying out of the particular competition and disciplines. Deviations from the International Rulebook are possible because of local or changed conditions. This will be announced on site.

1.7 Starting Documents

International clubs have to confirm with attachment 1 "Endorsement of Eligibility", that with their registration all competitors of the team fulfill all conditions mentioned.

Competitors with incomplete documents will be excluded from participation.

1.8 Venue

The DLRG Cup 2023 will be held in the Sport Beach Arena at beach section 1 in Warnemünde. Further information will be sent to the registered teams via mail.

1.8.1 Access Venue and Storage of Equipment

On the beach there will be a marked area for the competitors' equipment and/or trailer. Please use only these areas and bring boards and skis, which are not in use, away from the competition area. Trailers and tents have to be signed with a name and a telephone number for reachability. Tents have to be set up safe within the marked area, please think of the weather conditions, the team is responsible for the safety. The organizer assumes no liability for loss, theft or accidental damage for the tents and equipment. To provide enough space for the trailers, boards and skis, we ask all teams to give us the necessary information in advance.

We point out that the vehicle access to the beach is generally not allowed. Only the organizer can make an exception for allowed motor vehicles, that may use the access. Inobservance can lead to an exclusion from the competition.

Trailers have to be pulled by the teams themselves (by hand) to the equipment storage location. On Thursday and Saturday, the concrete path is only usable very limited for arriving and departing teams due to the necessary assembly and dismantling work.

Time Schedule for the Transport of the Trailers on the Tar Road:

Thursday 13.7.2023: 8.30 a.m. till approx. 10:00 a.m. and probably in the afternoon.

Saturday 15.7.2023: 2 p.m.till approx. 4 p.m., (with beginning of removal at the beach,

only upon approval by the event management).

Sunday, 16.7.2023: 9.00 a.m. till 12.00 a.m.

1.9 Equipment/Clothing

Equipment for the competition parcours and rescue tubes are provided by the organizer. There is no equipment pool (ski, boards...) available.

Used equipment has to accord to the Rulebook (1.6).

Competitors are permitted to use their own equipment only if it is scrutinized by the judge. The organizer reserves the right to brand the equipment (also the scrutinized equipment).

Participating teams are not allowed to show their own sponsors if they are in concurrence to the event-sponsor. Therefore, the participating teams have to inform the organizer with registration about their supporting advertising partners. The organizer has the right (until the end of competition) to withdraw the eligibility to start in case of non-compliance.

For security reasons and identification, each competitor and assistant, who takes part in a discipline, has to wear a pink lycra during the competition, except for the disciplines "beach flag", "beach sprint" and "beach sprint relay". Lycra vests can be acquired at the DLRG headquarter - Materialstelle. During all events, each active participant at a discipline has to wear a uniform team cap, which is fixed below the chin.

All teams, who have not registered their team caps yet, please send an E-Mail with a description (colour, design, shading) or a photo of the team cap to: cup@dsg.dlrg.de (please see overview attached). If a team has changed the design of its cap, this has to be announced also.

The individual start ID has to be applied visibly and recognizably on both upper arms.

1.10 Officials

Officials will be invited by the organizer separately.

1.11 Doping Tests

All competitors, coaches, team managers, officials and other involved persons are following the ILS Anti-Doping Policy. The DLRG Cup is announced to the National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA). Doping tests may be executed during the competition.

1.12 Time Schedule

All events are planned on Friday and Saturday between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. and on Thursday from 1 p.m. to 6 p.m. If not all disciplines can be realized in this time, the competition may be stopped at 6 p.m. with the results of finished finals at this time. A non-binding time schedule will be published before the event. In daily team manager meetings, which will take place on Thursday noon, Thursday evening and Friday evening after the competition, further general information for the schedule will be provided.

2 Registration

Registration for the 25. DLRG Cup 2023 is only possible online at

https://organet.info/

Application is based on a procedure of registration and login. Every user of this software registers with name, first name, mail address and password. After that, a confirmation and a link will be sent to the mentioned e-mail address. After that, the registration for competition can be done. An editing of the registration is only possible after release by the organizer.

2.1 Registration Period

Registration via Organet is possible between 15.05. and 15.06.2023.

2.2 Registration Approval

The Number of competitors at the DLRG Cup is limited to 360. The organizer reserves the right, to refuse starting, when the number of registered participants is achieved before deadline. Those, who register afterwards, will be put on a waiting list. If there are cancellations or defaulters successors will be approved in chronological order.

Successors will be informed up to 14 days before the competition. Furthermore, the organizer reserves the right to refuse the permission to start when the terms of registration and payment are not fulfilled.

2.3 Publication List of Registration

4 Costs

4.1 Entry Fee

Entry fee is 10,00 € for each single start and 15,00 € for each relay start.

4.2 Increased Entry Fee (IEF)

An increased entry fee of additionally 50 € for each heat becomes due in the following cases:

- a) if a competitor does not appear to the DLRG Cup
- b) if registered competitors do not appear to heat, semi-finals or finals during the competition

The IEF does not incur:

- a) if the club cancels the participation of the athletes at least 4 weeks before start of competition at https://organet.info
- b) if the club shows a medical certificate for the competitor after expiry of the four weeks mentioned in a)
- c) if the club nominates a substitute for the initial competitor till maximum one day before the beginning of competition (3 p.m.) or the replacement has been sent via mail to cup@dsg.dlrg.de (substitute has to compete in the same disciplines).
- d) if the registered competitor has cancelled his participation individually and in writing before the marshalling of the respective discipline.

The IEF has to be paid immediately on the organizers request on site. If the IEF is not paid, the organizer can refuse the continuance of the competition to all competitors from the respective club.

4.3 Overall Award Ceremony

The overall award ceremony will take place on Saturday, July 15th, before the closing event, on the stage in front of the pavilion. Participation is free of charge for all participants, athletes, coaches and guests. The exact start as well as possible bad weather alternatives will be communicated during the competition.

4.3 Participation Fee for Evening Program

After the award ceremony, the pavilion opens for the Closing event. Each participant, competitor, officials, accompanying person etc. has to pay a participation fee of 25,00 € for the Closing event. This fee has to be booked online together with the registration (includes dinner catering without drinks). Guests may -if there is capacity– acquire a ticket during the competition days for 28,00 €. For the access to the Closing event a valid ticket is necessary, solely the ID card for participants does not permit to join this event.

Attention: we indicate that it is not allowed, to take drinks of any kinds to the Closing event; Security is authorised to take it away.

And we indicate, that the Closing event must end at 24:00 due to official requirements.

4.4 Travel Costs

Travel expenses have to be covered by the participants.

5 Safety Measures

Safety for all participants has the highest priority during the competition. The instructions of the responsible persons have to be accepted. The used equipment must be in the condition, that every injury and danger is eliminated for the participants. Wetsuits may be worn at water temperatures below of 16° Celsius. At water temperature below of 13° C, wearing of wetsuits is obligatory. Furthermore we point out to 1.9– lycras.

We inform all competitors, that during the competition photos and videos will be made. This material is used for the media representation of the public event "DLRG Cup". There is no need for a special agreement concerning the publication of photo-graphed persons. The authorised

For further usage, especially for a commercial use, DLRG will contact the relevant person, if it is necessary according to §22 and §23 KunstUrhG.

By registering, the participants declare that they have read and understood this regulation and agree to its application.

FINALS AND SCORING IN LIFESAVING CHAMPIONSHIPS



FINALS AND SCORING in the following LIFESAVING CHAMPIONSHIPS: Int. German Cup, DLRG-Trophy, Youth Championships

a) For point score purposes finals have to be conducted. Points are possible for the place 1 to 16.

Pool and Ocean Events.

- Individual Ocean events: The highest placed number of competitors, based on heats, are qualified for a final. (The max. number of competitors should be geared to the competition handbook.)
- Team Ocean events: The highest placed number of competitors, based on heats, are qualified for a final. (The max. number of competitors should be geared to the competition handbook.)
- Ocean events, where the number of available starting positions is lower than the number of lanes (e.g. Rescue Board Rescue, Rescue Tube Rescue, Beach Sprint): The highest placed number of competitors, based on heats, are qualified for a Final, where the final is divided into A and B and/or C finals. (The max. number of competitors should be geared to the competition handbook.)
- Pool events: The fastest competitors/teams, based on heats, are assigned to positions in an A and B and/or C final, by filling up the max number of available lanes, but not more than 8 competitors at each final.
- b) Teams competing in Teams Open and Youth championships shall be allocated the following points based on team member placing in finals.

1 st	20	9 th	8
2 nd	18	10 th	7
3 rd	16	11 th	6
4 th	14	12 th	5
5 th	13	13 th	4
6 th	12	14 th	3
7 th	11	15 th	2
8 th	10	16 th	1

In determining the point score ranking please note:

- There shall be no point score blocking. All competitors are eligible to earn points for their team.
- In finals, if two teams/competitors tie for first, each receives first-place points (20). The next placed team/competitor is awarded third place and receives 16 points, and so on. Ties in this team ranking point scores shall be broken using the following system:
- Most first-place final finishes.
- Most second-place final finishes.
- Most third-place final finishes; and so on.

If, for whatever reason, a final will not take place (e.g. a B or C final can't be conducted due to time constraints), the points will be calculated using the arithmetic average, based on the placing of the previous heats (divided by the number of previous heats).




- Competitors or teams must advise, if they intend to withdraw from an A or B (or C) final, within a predefined time before starting the finals. Competitors or teams who withdraw or do not start (DNS) in an A or B (or C) final shall not earn any points for their team's point score (i.e. zero points are scored for a "no show").
- If one or more competitors/teams in any championship withdraw from an A or B (or C) final, competitors/teams shall be called forward to finals as detailed in the current edition ILS Competition Rule Book.
- Competitors who do not finish (DNF) or who are disqualified in a final shall earn the points of the last place of this final (also for straight finals), but no placing.
- Points and places of following finals stay unchanged.
- However, competitors shall not earn any points if they are disqualified for "competing unfairly" or for a "serious discipline offence". (See Section 2.16 Misconduct in the current edition ILS Competition Rule Book.)
 - Note: For clarification of "elimination" vs "disqualification" for Beach Flags refer to the Beach Flags event description in the current edition ILS Competition Rule Book.
- No points shall be credited to any team if an event is cancelled even if some heats have been conducted.











Übersicht der DLRG-Landesverbände:
