0 Preliminary note

The development of the pandemic continues to be a major challenge in terms of planning the 2022 German Cup. The health of all athletes, coaches and employees is our top priority. However, we are pleased that we are able to organise the event in Warendorf according to the current status.

Of course, the event is subject to the current developments of the Covid 19 pandemic and the official requirements. If necessary, we will inform you about an adjustment of the framework conditions for the 28th Int. German Cup.

The International German Cup is planned as a traditional event:

- Opening Ceremony
- Overall award ceremony in the sports hall
- Closing Ceremony
- Offer for Lunch for the delegations
- **Attention: No overnight stays are offered in the gym of the sports school**

The organizer expressly reserves the right to cancel, postpone or change the event in parts or completely at short notice due to official requirements or own risk and safety assessments and to introduce security measures that may conflict with the applicable regulations. This reservation is valid to all components of the following invitation.

Entry fees will be refunded pro rata if cancellations or partial cancellations by the organizer are necessary. Any additional costs of the clubs cannot be refunded.

2 Competition

2.1 Competition procedure / Schedule

The competition of the 28th International German Cup 2022 will be held in Warendorf from Nov. 17 to Nov. 20, 2022.

You can find the temporary schedule in **attachment No.1** for orientation, this will be a non-binding time schedule.

Please note that in particular the starting times and the order of the events may change during the competition.

The competition of the 28th International German Cup will take place in Warendorf on November 18th and 19th 2022.

2.2 Age Groups

All participants born in or before 2007 will be given a score in one age group separately for male and female participants.

2.3 Events according to ILS rulebook

A Individual events: (male/female)

- 200m Obstacle Swim
- 100m Manikin Tow with Fins
- 100m Rescue Medley
- 100m Manikin Carry with Fins
- 50m Manikin Carry
- 200m Super Lifesaver

B Team events: (male/female)

- Line Throw
- 4x50m Obstacle Relay
- 4x50m Medley Relay
- 4x25m Manikin Relay

C Team Events: (mixed)

- 4 x 50m Mixed Pool Lifesaver Relay
- SERC

Each competitor can only start once in each event.

2.4 Eligibility

Participants:

- a) Regional federations of the DLRG
- b) National teams of ILS full members

Composition of the delegation a and b:

A delegation may consist of at least 1 participant and a maximum of 12 participants:

- 1 delegation leader / team leader
- 1 coach / attendant
 - 1 team (male), 5 males at the most, born in 2007 and older
 - 1 team (female), 5 females at the most, born in 2007 and older

Competitors may only start for the national association for which they are exclusively allowed to start in the current competition year.

2.5 Competition / Pointscore

Awards will be presented in the categories listed below. The top three in each category receive medals. For the overall ranking (category C and D), trophies will be awarded in separate rankings for German regional federations and national teams.

- A) Each competitor may compete in up to five individual events in accordance with sect. 2.3 A. The best four results will be included in the individual overall point score.
- B) Overall relay point score (separated in males and females)
Each delegation can compete in up to four relays in accordance with section 2.3 B, all results (separately for males and females) will be included in the overall relay point score
- C) Overall scoring for German regional clubs is the result of:
 - The best four male and female individuals overall scorings (Competition A)
 - The best male and female relay scoring (Competition B)
 - The team scoring for the mixed events 2.3 C (SERC, Mixed Pool Lifesaver Relay)
- D) Overall scoring for National teams is the result of
 - I. The best four male and female individuals overall scorings (Competition A)
 - II. The best male and female relay scoring (Competition B)
 - III. The team scoring for the mixed events 2.3 C (SERC, Mixed Pool Lifesaver Relay)

The basis of the scoring are rating points based on the scorecard of the national DLRG rulebook. The world record, which is valid before the start of the event, is set at 1000 points. The points are then scored by a scoring formula.

For the SERC-competition the scoring points will be multiplied by a factor, which will only be determined after setting the SERC-scenario and the scoring table by the officials. The factor will be announced during the team manager meeting.

2.5.1 Result Announcement

Intermediate and final results will be published in the swimming hall. Objections against these results have to be announced as regulated in the ILS Competition Rulebook.

2.5.2 Award Ceremony

The award ceremony will be held on Saturday evening in the gym A.

2.6 Rulebook

The competition at the 28th International German Cup 2022 will be held according to the international rules of the ILS Competition Rulebook.

If the ILS publishes an update after the publication of this announcement and before the German Cup 2022, the new rules will apply.

In case of discrepancies between the ILS Competition Rulebook and this announcement the latter shall prevail.

Deviating from the ILS rule book, the regulations from §4 (1) of the DLRG national rule book (as of 01.01.2020) apply in principle.

The international regulation (ILS-Rulebook) obliges participants and volunteers to wear a swimming cap and describe the permissible swimwear.

2.7 Membership documents

The organizer reserves the right to check the identity of the participants by means of an identity card or passport.

2.9 Equipment

The following equipment will be provided by the organizer and has to be used by the participants according to the rules:

- Rescue tubes
- obstacles
- manikins
- Throw lines
- Pedestal superlifesaver

2.10 Officials

The invitation or nomination of the officials will be sent in a separate letter from the representative for the officials.

2.11 Doping control

In accordance with ILS regulations and the implementation of the decision of the chairmanship of the DLRG, doping controls are planned for this international competition. If there are new World or European records, a doping control will be executed in any case.

3 Registration procedure

3.1 Registration

Registration for the competition is possible exclusively online at <https://organet.info/>

The registration of DP2022 is made either by the regional clubs of the DLRG or by the international ILS member association.

With the registration the team manager has to accept the "Endorsement of Eligibility", and the "Data protection notice".

3.2 Registration Date

Registration deadline for the competition is **Oct. 24th, 2022**

Please note that your registration needs to be processed for the competition and it can take up to 24 hours before activation. Changes of registrations after the official registration deadline will not be considered. Changes of the individual participants for an event before the start of the competition will not be accepted. Participants for the team competitions must be registered by name till the closing deadline.

Participants in team events can be exchanged as long as they fulfill the other terms and conditions of participation. The exchange must be submitted in writing by the teammanager to the event management at least 30 minutes before the start of the team event.

Participation can be denied in case of late registration or missing payments. The deadline has to be adhered strictly.

3.3 Announcement of entry list

Entry lists will be published till Oct. 27, 2022. Corrections, i.e. misspellings, can be made until Oct. 30, 2022. In this case please send an email to dp@dlrg.de with the subject line: "DP2022: *Nation* / Team – Correction".

4 General Conditions

4.1 Accommodation and meals

Lunch and dinner during the competition days will be bookable via Organet.

4.2 References

Parking and driving within the sports school area:

It is not allowed to drive or use the parking area within the area of the sports school of German Forces in Warendorf. All cars and busses have to be parked outside at the parking place "Lange Wieske". From there you can get through an entrance by feet to the swimming hall. The entrance at the guardhouse (Dr. Rau-Allee) can only be used by feet.

4.3 Opening ceremony, award ceremony and party

A solemn opening ceremony will take place on Thursday, Nov. 17, 2022. The venue will be announced in time.

The final award ceremony will take place in the sports hall A on Saturday, Nov. 19, 2022.

Following the award ceremony, there will be a party within the sports school.

5 Costs

5.1 Event Costs

Each delegation has to pay a participation fee of **250, - EUR**, irrespective of the total number of participants.

5.2 Travel expenses

Travel expenses have to be paid by the participating delegation itself.

Please bring a confirmation of payment (the bank transfer), the team will not be able to participate if fees were not paid. Costs cannot be reimbursed in case of cancellation after the registration deadline.

6 Safety measures

We expressly point out that bringing of chairs of any kind is not permitted. The swimming hall has ample grandstand seats. The athletes are only allowed to stay inner area of the pool during the completion of the respective discipline. All other persons, in particular trainers/supervisors, are not permitted to stay there.

The DLRG photographers and camera crews take care and ensure the privacy rights of the photographed persons and will take care that other media representatives will be careful as well.

The DLRG reserves the right to continue to use images and film recordings made on its behalf for internal association purposes (e.g. presentation of rescue sports in public in general, use in information and teaching materials, posters, etc.).

For further applications, in particular of a commercial nature, the DLRG will contact the person photographed in individual cases, insofar as this is necessary according to §22 and §23 KunstUrhG.

By registering, the participants agree to this.
