The European Lifesaving Championships 2019 will take place in Riccione, Italy, hosted by our member federation, Federazione Italiana Nuoto (Sezione Salvamento) (FIN-S) from 17th September to 30th September 2019. The following European Lifesaving Championships will be conducted:



- Masters
- National Team Open
- National Team Youth
- Interclub Team Open
- Interclub Team Youth

Registration for the Championships is now open. In order to register you must follow the instructions on the event website: [2019 European Lifesaving Championships](#)

You must first register with the ORION Sky Global agency to select your accommodation and service package for you and your team. On confirming your order, you are then given a code which you use to register your team and competitors into the OrgaNet registration system. Please note you will not be able to register your team into OrgaNet without the code that you obtain from the ORION website.

If your club/team name is already registered on the **ILS List of Approved Club Names**, when you select your federation you will find your club/team name and can select it to continue. If your club/team name is not one of the 1,400 names on that list, you will be able to ask ILS to register using the ORION system.

Accommodation and Service Package Registration and Purchase

Initial Registration through the ORION Sky Global site is required by all teams. This is necessary to get the necessary accommodation and service packages that will also generate the code required to enter the OrgaNet competition system [OrgaNet v2.0](#). All participants must be registered because through this process their individual entry fees will be managed.

However, in response to feedback received from federations and club teams, the process of registering and purchasing packages has been reviewed to make it more flexible.

1. The amount of the deposit that should be paid on confirming the purchase is being reduced from 70% to 50% with the balance payable within 4 weeks of the first date of the stay.
2. FIN-S recognises that not all participants will need to purchase the minimum 5 days accommodation package. They will be able to discuss their requirements with ORION Sky Global directly to find a package that will suit them.
3. The rates shown in the attached table at **Appendix 1** for competitors and team officials are for either a 5 night or 8 night stay Bed & Breakfast, Half Board, or Full Board. To request a different number of nights, **or for stays less than 5 nights**, teams **must** make contact by e-mail in the first instance with the team at ORION using the info@orionskyglobal.com e-mail address **before registering**.
4. FIN-S has also agreed that the hi-vis lycra vest that must be worn in Ocean competition, will now be supplied to all participants free of charge, meaning that for all participants the package cost will be reduced by €20.

When assessing the costs of the package purchase, all participants must take account of the full costs of the benefits of accommodation and services that are offered which are summarised here:

A. Accommodation

- Guaranteed accommodation in selected hotels and apartments in Riccione, with a vast selection of packages in different categories and meal options from B&B to Full Board
- All Local City Accommodation Taxes are included in the price
- Deposit on initial purchase reduced from 70% to 50%

Transport

- Welcome and Information Desk at Bologna Airport Arrivals
- Welcome and Information Desk at Bologna Railway Station Arrivals
- Arrival & Departure Transfers from/to Bologna Airport and from/to Bologna Railway Station, by dedicated transportation to be arranged to meet the participant's needs

- Local transport transfers provided free of charge from the hotels to the Pool and Beach Venues

B. Training

- Free use of the training pool for three days prior to competition
- Complimentary use of pool facilities for pre-competition training
- At least a 50% discount on the hiring of additional training pool facilities outside of this period

C. Competition

- All individual fees for participation in the Championships
- Free provision of lycra hi-vis competition vests
- Free transport to the pool and ocean competition venues during the competition
- Complimentary storage of Boards and Skis at the competition venue with onsite security
- Each participant will be entitled to receive one free official photograph from the Official Championships Photography supplier

D. Additional accreditation for spectators/supporters

- Free accreditation for spectators/spectators (a maximum of 2 persons for every competitor in the team) with local transport service, access to special viewing zones during the competitions and merchandising discounts

E. Other

- Onsite English-speaking staff to assist
- Assistance with online registration and purchase of packages
- Local discounts on services and facilities
- Onsite dedicated staff assistance
- Assistance with any visa issues
- Assistance with organising any local tourist tours

Registration Deadlines

The Championships registration dates are as follows:

- April 1st to April 30th – Early registration
- May 1st to August 3rd – Normal registration
- August 4th to August 17th – Late registration

- **All individual fees** are collected by ORION through the initial package purchase process
- This will give the user an Access code that is then used to enter the team and competitors into the events in [OrgaNet v2.0](#)

- **All team fees** are collected by [OrgaNet v2.0](#) through the competition entry process
- All competition entries must be made by teams in OrgaNet using an Access Code that is supplied by ORION for each event

- A full team fee is payable if a team in the National/Interclub Open/Youth event comprises at least 4 team members from the same gender
- A full team fee is payable if a team in the Masters' event comprises at least 4 team members from the same gender in the pool events, or at least 3 in the ocean events
